**MAUI NON-PROFIT AGENCIES RECEIVE \$353,536
FROM THE 2005 MERCEDES CHAMPIONSHIPS**

LAHAINA, MAUI, HAWAI'I (March 30, 2005) – Kapalua Maui Charities, Inc., the host organization of the 2005 Mercedes Championships, proudly unveiled a check in the amount of \$353,536 at a Charity Reception held March 30 at the J. Walter Cameron Center in Wailuku. Richard Cameron, president of the Board of Directors presented the check to representatives from eleven non-profit organizations.

The eleven designated organizations receiving the proceeds from the 2005 Mercedes Championships are the Boy Scouts of America - Maui County Council, Friends of the Children's Justice Center, Girl Scout Council of Hawai'i, Hale Makua, J. Walter Cameron Center, Ka Lima O Maui, Lahainaluna High School Foundation, Maui Junior Golf Association, Maui Memorial Medical Center Foundation, Maui Preparatory Academy, and The Art School at Kapalua.

The Mercedes Championships, played at Kapalua Resort's Plantation Course earlier this year, Jan. 3 - 9, drew an impressive crowd of over 28,000 spectators. Every year, an extraordinary number of volunteers including those from the designated beneficiaries contribute their time and talent to assist with various aspects of the tournament.

"The partnership that we've forged with these fine charitable organizations has been a win-win situation for all involved," said Cameron. "Since 1999, Kapalua Maui Charities, Inc. has contributed over \$1.7 million to the Maui community. Each year we've achieved our goal of increasing the amount raised by the tournament from \$183,000 in 1999 to over \$350,000 today."

A portion of the proceeds from the Mercedes Championships has been designated specifically to support West Maui projects. Those organizations seeking donations may call the Mercedes Championships tournament office at (808) 669-2440 for applications. Completed applications are due by April 15, 2005.

Non-profit entities with 501(c)3 status interested in becoming a designated beneficiary for the 2005 Mercedes Championships should also call the tournament office for a separate application. All applications are due April 15, 2005.

Early qualifiers include Tiger Woods, Vijay Singh, David Toms, Phil Mickelson, Justin Leonard, Fred Funk, Kenny Perry, Geoff Ogilvy and defending champion Stuart Appleby.
